



Louisville VA Replacement Medical Center Project – Fact Sheet

Past:

- **2004**—VA conducts Capital Asset Realignment and Enhanced Services (CARES) study. Louisville VA Medical Center (VAMC) is found to have significant deficiencies.
- **2009**—VA completes feasibility study, and finds the Louisville VAMC needs to be replaced.
- **2010**—VA Site Selection Board selects top three sites.
- **2012**—After thorough analysis of all sites, VA buys land for a new VAMC on Brownsboro Road and completes a Final Master Plan.

Present:

- **2014**—Louisville VA Replacement Medical Center Activation Team continues working with VA Construction and Facilities Management (CFM) and contracted Architects and Engineers (A&E) processing schematic designs, which is the first of six design phases to take place before construction begins.
- **2014**— In June, VAMC and Activation Team Leadership, VA Construction Facilities Management, and the Architect & Engineer Team present initial schematic designs to VA Leadership in Washington DC. The project is approved to move forward into Schematic Design Phase Two, which is the second of six design phases.
- **2014** -- In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), an independent contractor is putting together a draft analysis the impact of the construction and operations of a new medical center will have on the Brownsboro Road site. Once the draft is released, a public meeting will be held in order to answer questions and gather further concerns community members might have.

Future:

- **2014-2016**—User group meetings with VAMC staff, Activation Team, Construction Facilities Management, and Architects and Engineers continue in order to design the most efficient and effective spaces possible for Veteran care.
- **2016-17**—Design phases end and construction begins (subject to Congressional approval and available funding)
- **2023**—Anticipated Grand Opening of the Louisville VA Replacement Medical Center.
